OUR STORY

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Muncie is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization serving over 400 registered members, throughout Delaware County, in two Clubs in Muncie, IN. We began our history serving children in 1933 by Branch McClung and a group of sorority women.

In 1944 the Boys Club of Muncie became a member of the Boys Club of America. In 1950 the Boys Club of Muncie broke ground on the current building in Heekin Park to recognize that girls are a part of our cause. The national organization's name changed to Boys & Girls Clubs of America in 1990. In January 2018, the Roy C. Buley Center and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Muncie completed a merger between the two organizations.



In 2023, the Clubs will celebrate 90 years serving youth.

OUR IMPACT



23,175 meals served

18,761 snacks served

13,824 hours of Power Hour programming per school year



72 Club members received support from an in-club counselor



70% of youth were able to pick out and correctly identify instruments including trombone, harp, tuba and trumpet









2/3 of our Club Members increased their math scores during the school year



94% Club Members engaged in MyFuture programming (over the previous year)



57% of our Club Members were able to determine what a primary color was given the choice of orange, yellow and green



2/3 of our kids learned through STEM programming that cell phones are not a requirement to live
