

Academic & Career Success

- 34% of 3rd graders increased or maintained their literacy scores
- During the summer, teens increased their reading scores by an average of 13.5% and their math scores by 13%.
- 73% of Club youth believe that they will go to college*
- 88% of teens believe that they will complete a junior college, trade school or 4-year college*
- 88% of Club youth choose activities that push them to learn new thing*



Healthy Lifestyles


- 50% of Club youth are physically active for a total of at least 60 minute on 5 or more days*
- 67% ate at least 3-5 fruits/vegetables per day*
- 89% says people at the Club accept me for who I am*
- 13% of teens increased their knowledge of life skills (adulting 101) over the summer




Character & Leadership

- 89% of youth believe that if they are a leader of a group, they make sure everyone in the group feels important*
- 89% of youth feel like they can stand up for what they think is right, even if their friends disagree*
- 93% of youth try to help when they see people in need*
- 88% of youth have done things to help people in their community*


Why do I serve?
